Prizes

Medals will be awarded in all grades and in accordance with the current SSAA rule book.

General

- Nominate if you are shooting left-handed or using a muzzle break on entry form.
- Centrefire 223, Centrefire Open and Rimfire events will require 30+ rounds of ammunition.
- Big Game event will require 15+ rounds of ammunition.
- Attendance of the safety and information briefing is mandatory for all competitors for each event.
- You must be a current financial member of SSAA to compete in this event.
- Valid SSAA membership cards to be shown and FAL to proof club use guns for each event.
- Soft drinks will be available for purchase throughout the day.
- Discipline Chairman meeting follows the 222/223 Match on Saturday 12 September. Delegates attending the meeting must have written authorization from the club Secretary/President. All Clubs are entitled to 2 votes.
